Lake Norman Christian School calculates both a weighted and unweighted grade point average (GPA). The weighted GPA is calculated as follows: +1 quality point for honors courses and +2 points for AP classes. Algebra I, ELA-I, Geography, Physical/Env. Science, and Spanish I can be taken in eighth grade for high school credit. However, the grade received is not calculated in the GPA. While dual enrollment courses are listed on the HS transcript, grades are not included in the GPA; students should submit a separate college transcript.

We provide an exact ranking of our graduates using the weighted GPA. In addition, we recognize a valedictorian, salutatorian, and those graduating with distinction.
